

CAREER IN AVIATION

Awarded to a senior who is interested in an aviation career: airline mechanic, flight engineer, pilot, air traffic controller. Sponsored by Jon Schlegel, class of 1975, and Dave Nordmeyer, class of 1965, and Doug Nordmeyer, class of 19763, in honor of their dad, Milton Nordmeyer.

DESMOND FAMILY FOUNDATION

Given in partnership with Normandale Community College, it honors a student who endured personal challenges and will attend NCC.

DICK WALKER MEMORIAL

Awarded to a senior football player with the highest GPA, who has played at least two seasons at RHS.
